Changing your Banner & Logo

FirePro allows a custom image and banner for use in the printing out of Operational Guidelines and various reports.

First you need to have your image open in an imaging program (like Photoshop, Paint, or whatever program you use). Select your image and "Copy" it (depending on the program, it could be edit → copy, or you may be able to click on the image with your right mouse button, then select "copy" from the pop up menu).

Next, in FirePro 2, go to:
Set-up → System Information

The Logo and Banner fields accept pasted-in images of your department logo and letterhead banner. Click the "Edit" button then click on the field you are changing (if you are changing the logo, click in the logo box, if you are changing the banner, click in the banner box).

Then from the top menu, edit → paste.
