Help Tips

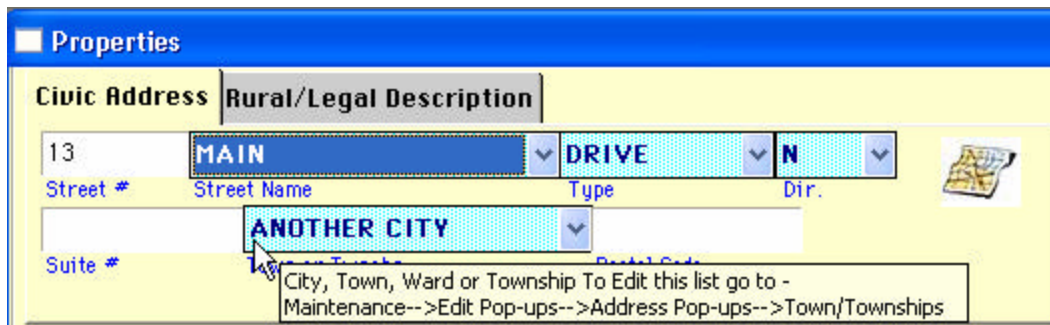
Not sure what a particular field, button, or menu item is for in FirePro 2?

Most buttons, fields and menu items have tips associated with them to help you understand what they are for, and, if applicable, how to edit or populate the information associated with them.

If you hold your mouse over a button or field in FirePro 2, a tip will pop up for you.

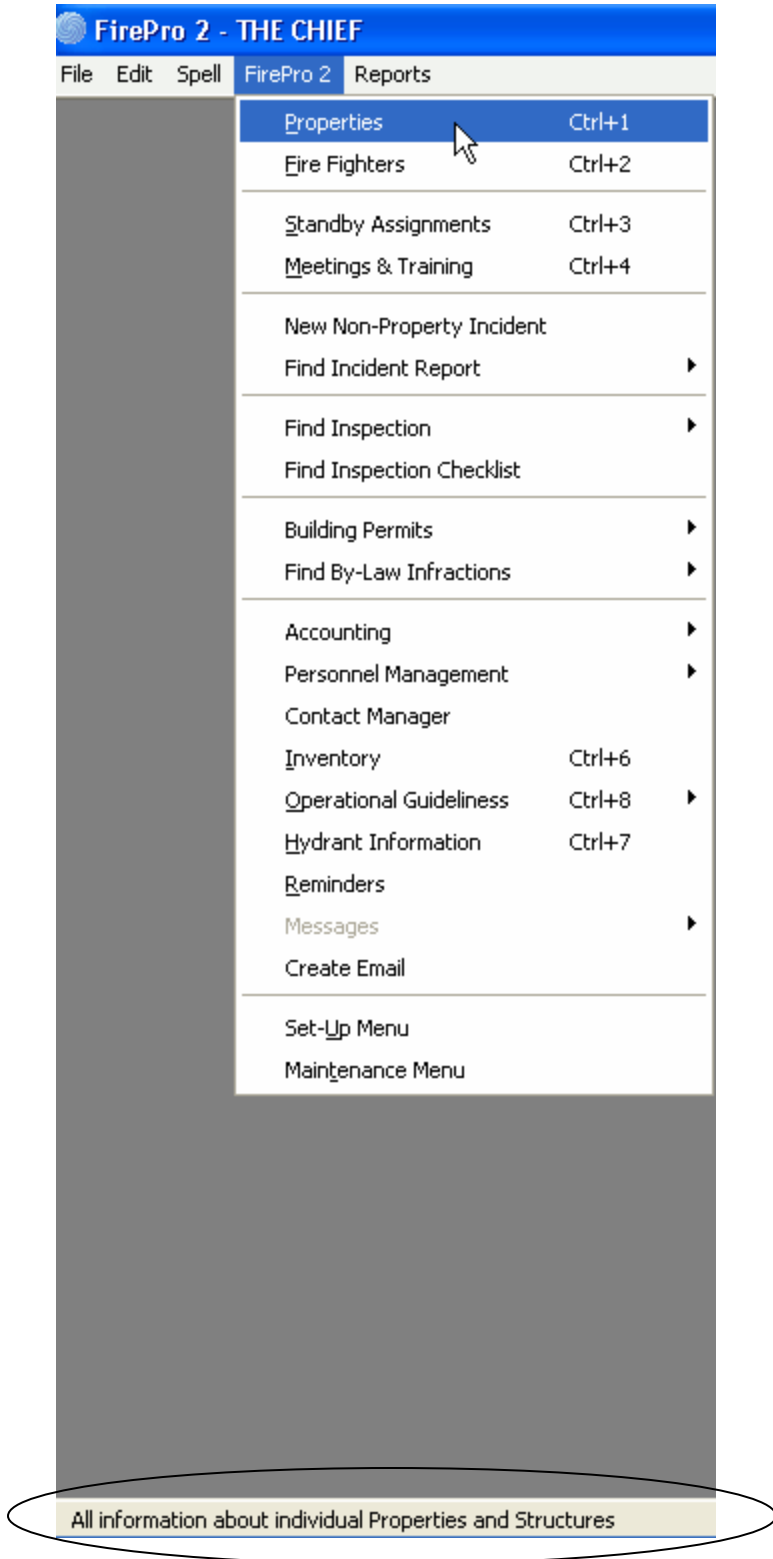
For example, when holding your mouse over the "Town or Township" field on the property window, you will see the message:

"City, Town, Ward, or Township. To edit this list, go to Maintenance → Edit Pop Ups → Address Pop Ups → Town/Townships" (shown below)



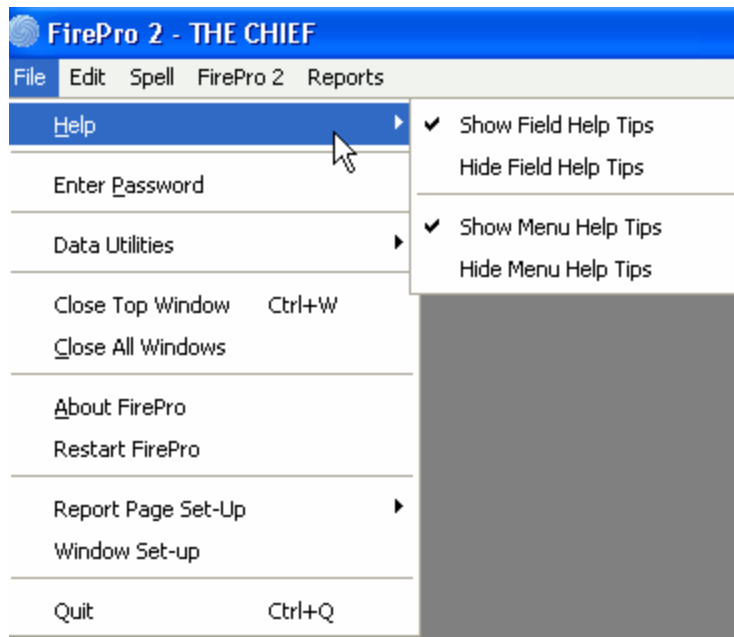
If you hold your mouse over a menu item, a description of the item will appear in the bottom bar of the window.

For example, when you hold your mouse over the FirePro 2 → Properties menu item, a description appears at the bottom of the screen as shown below.



To turn these features on or off, go to
File → Help →

Be sure that the “Show Field Help Tips” and “Show Menu Help Tips” have checkmarks beside them. If they don’t, you can click on them to turn them on.
