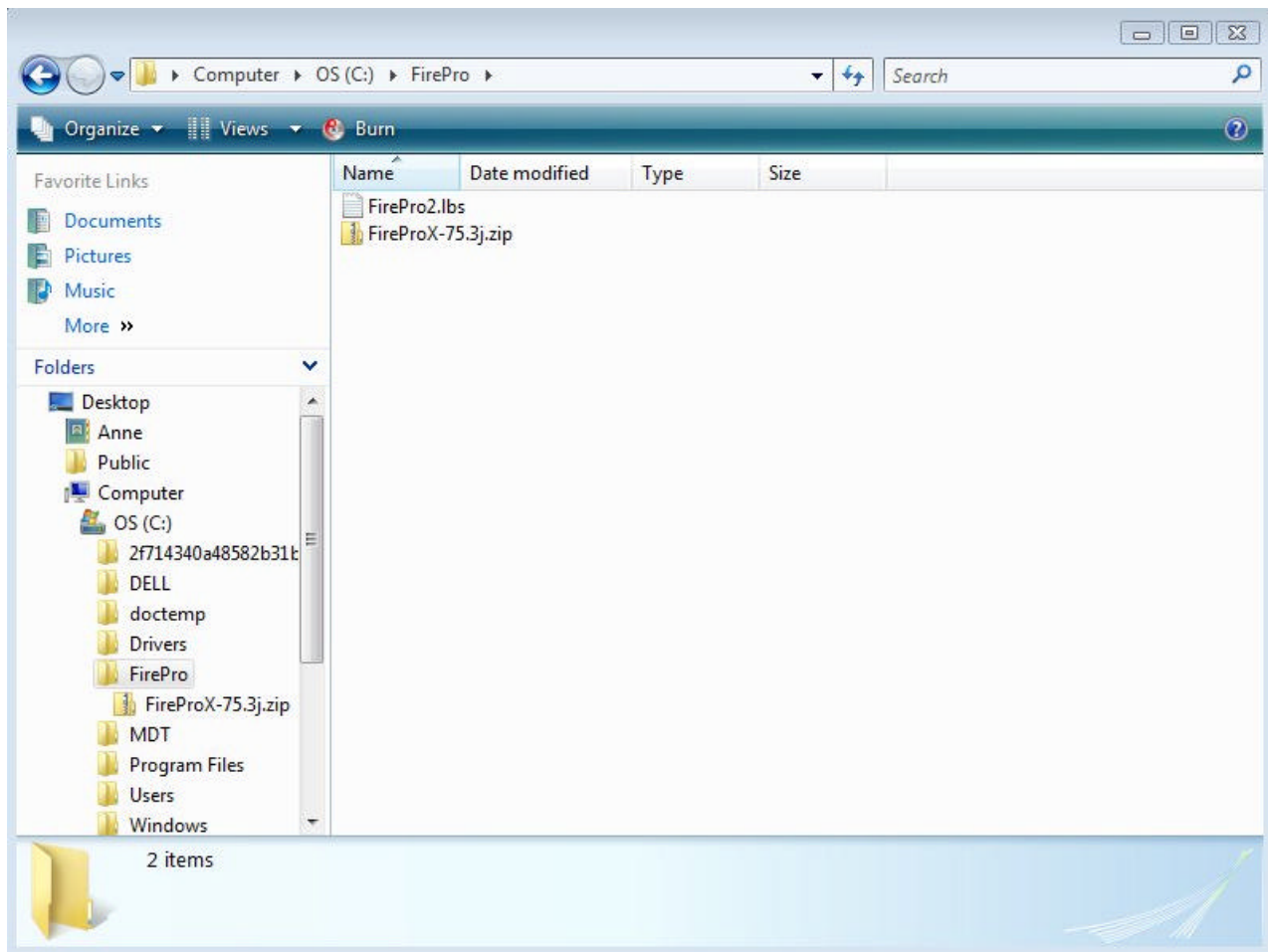


### Installing Updates on a Vista Computer

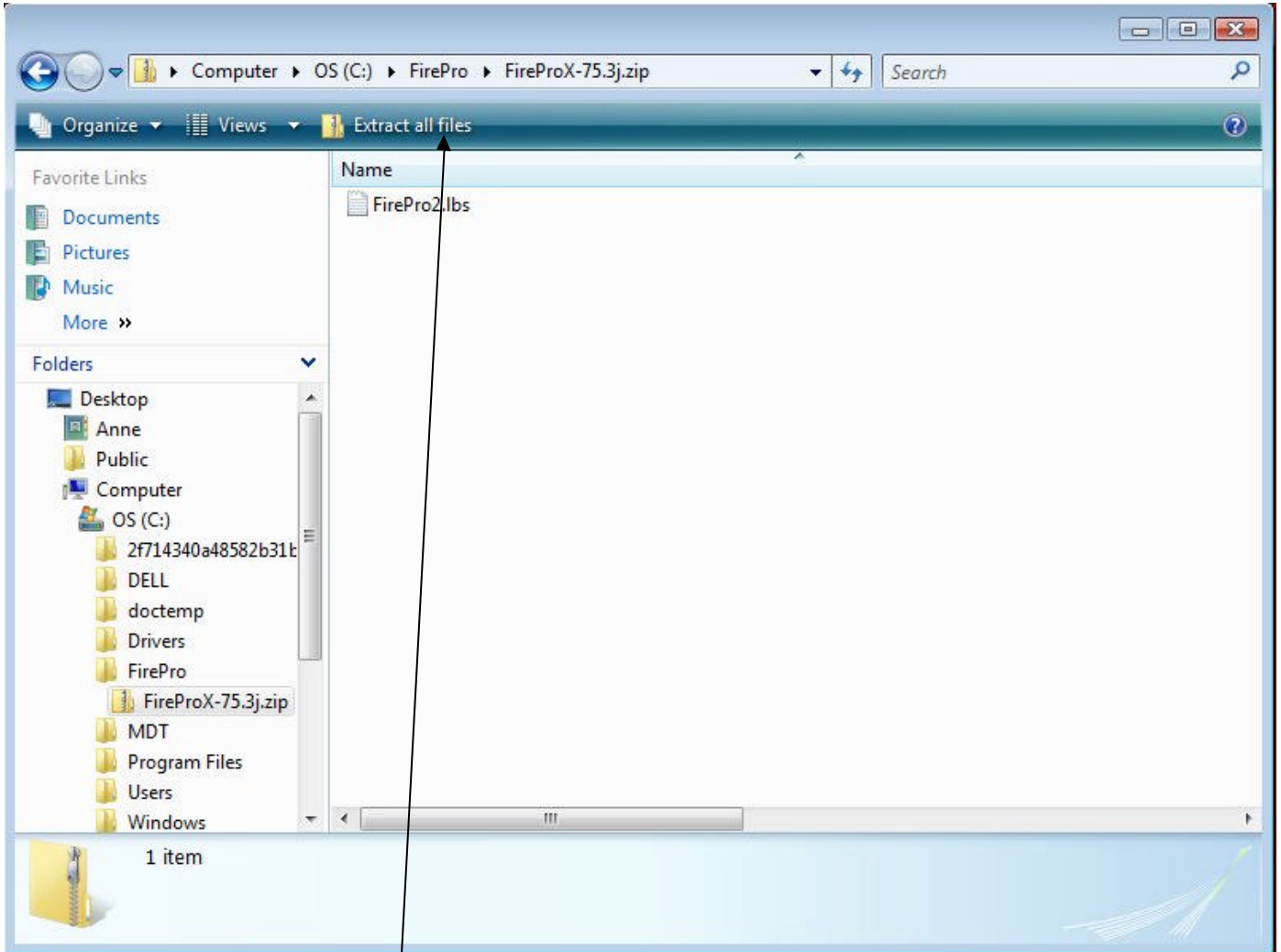
If your computer is running the new Vista operating system, the “unzipper” does something you don’t really want it to do!

When you receive an update from us, you will need to be careful as to the location that the program creates for the files. Usually, Vista will create a new folder with the name of the zip file and puts the file in that folder. This is definitely not where you want your FirePro files.

Most often, the best thing to do is save the zip file to your FirePro folder (rather than open it directly from the e-mail). Note that we are not showing all the files in our example – just the ones you need to be concerned with when installing updates.

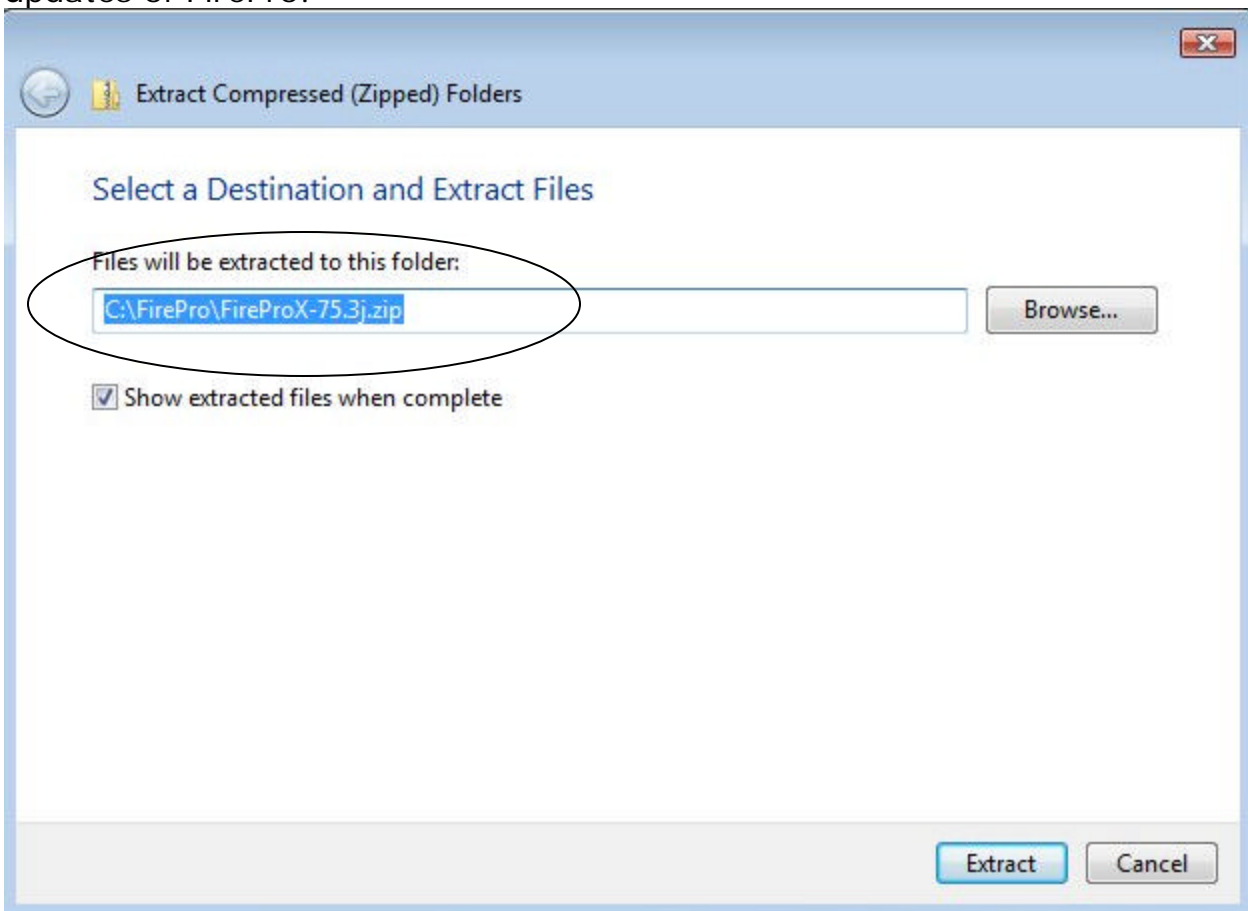


Open the zip folder and you will see the following:

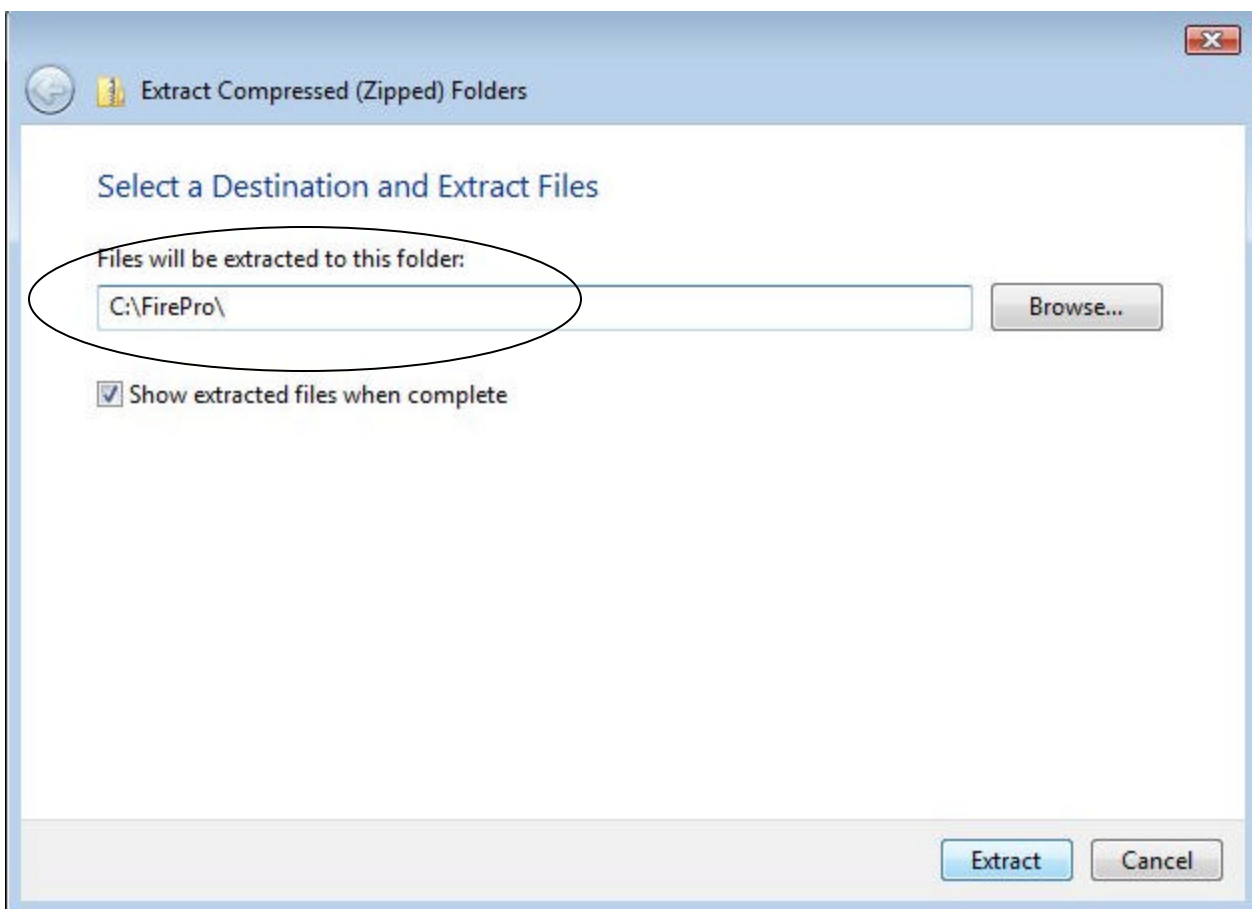


Click on "Extract All Files"

This will open the following window. Note that Vista automatically creates a destination folder based on the file name – this is not a good thing for installing updates of FirePro!

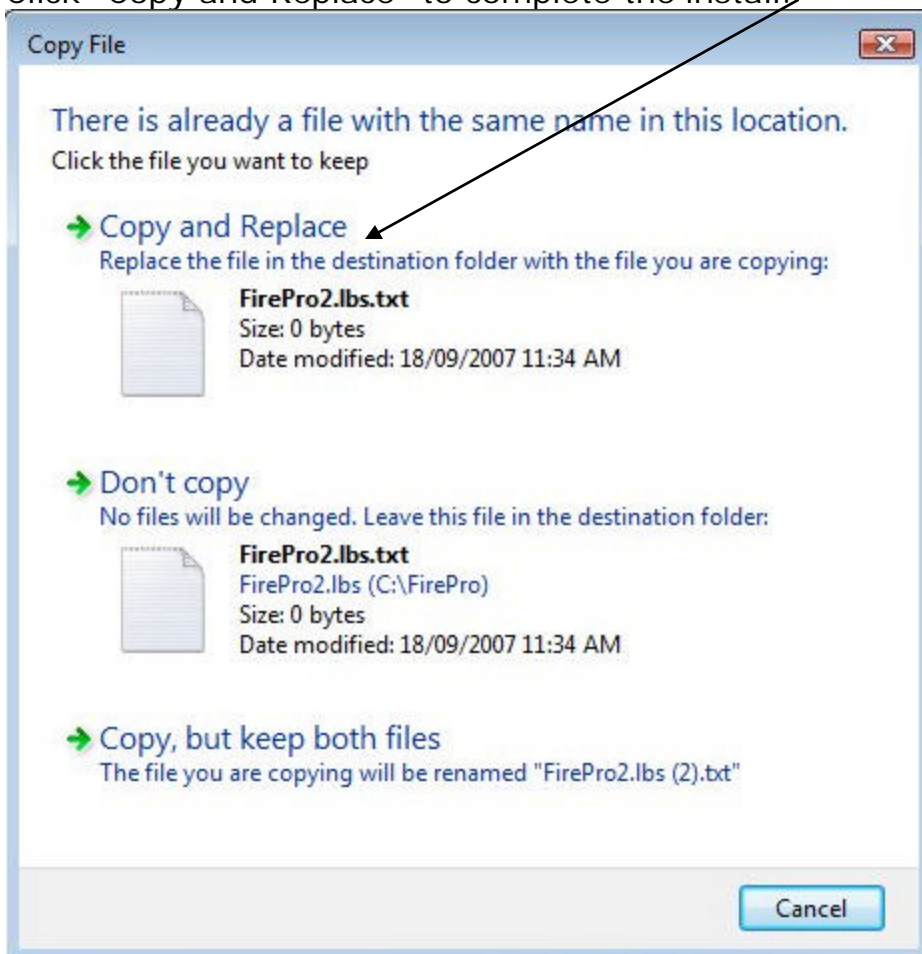


Remove the FireProX-75.3j.zip from the destination (note: will be FireProX- whatever the current version number is.zip) as shown below.



Click "Extract". You should then get the following window. If you don't, something is wrong with where you are placing the file and you need to go back and double check your file locations .

Click "Copy and Replace" to complete the install.
